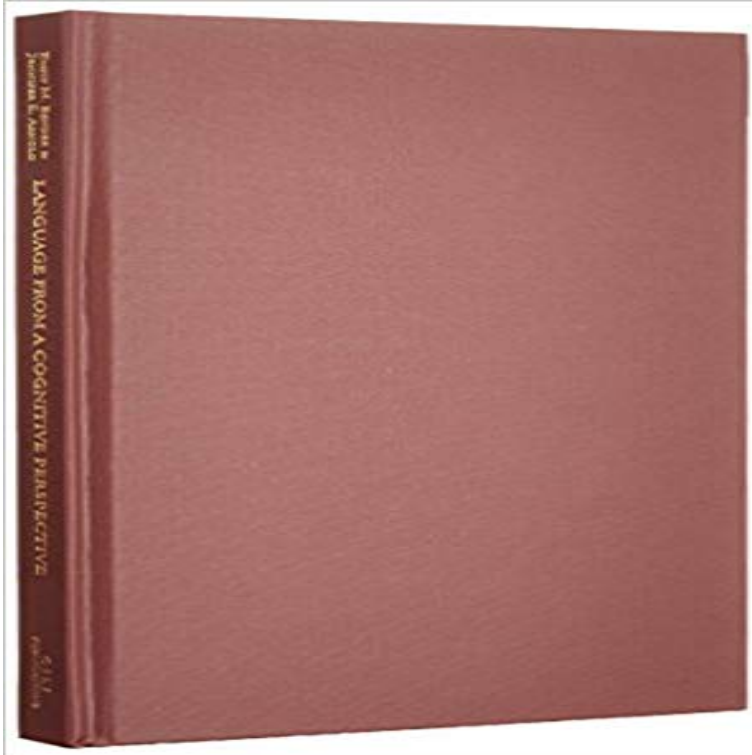


Language from a Cognitive Perspective: Grammar, Usage, and Processing (Lecture Notes)
