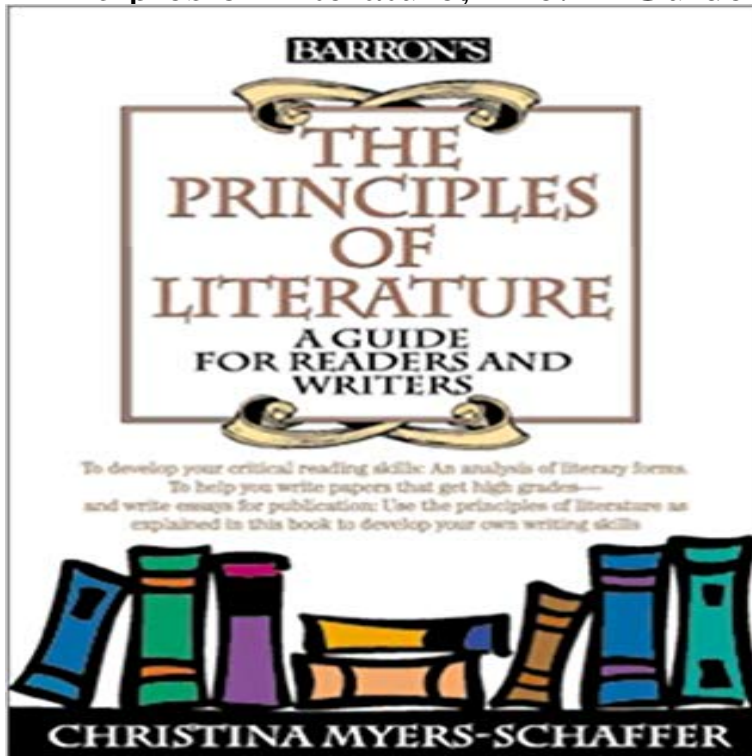


## Principles of Literature, The: A Guide for Readers and Writers
