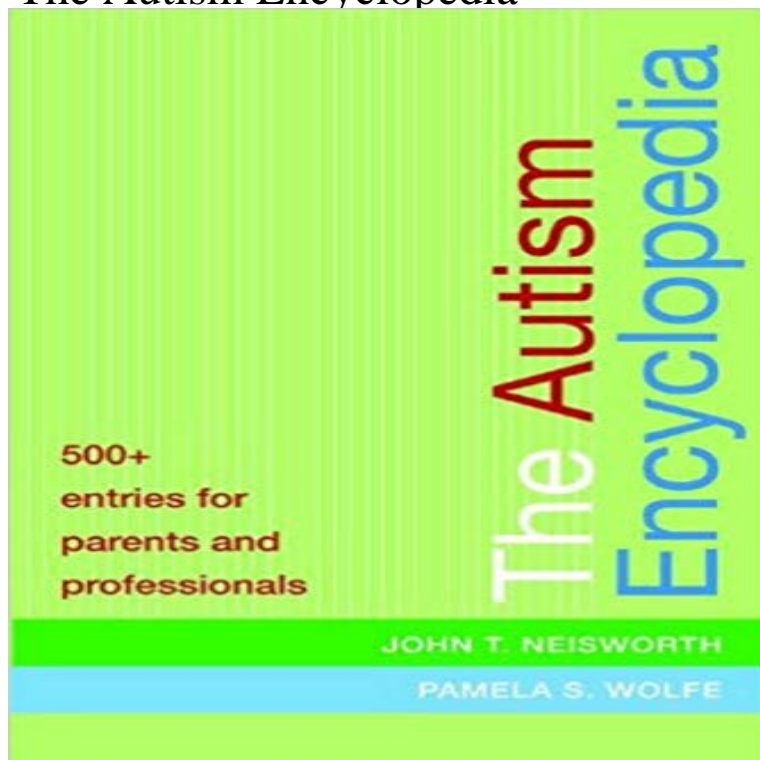


The Autism Encyclopedia
